### LOCATION

&Beyond Bateleur Camp is situated on the western border of the Masai Mara Game Reserve in southwestern Kenya. Set on a private concession leased from Maasai landlords, the camp lies at the base of the Oloololo escarpment just below the spot where *Out of Africa's* most famous scene was shot. The camp overlooks the plains of the Masai Mara and lies directly in the path of what is considered to be the greatest spectacle in the animal kingdom - the annual migration of wildebeest and zebra from the Serengeti National Park of Tanzania.

## ACCESS

Air Kenya and Safari Link operates two scheduled flights a day from Nairobi's Wilson Airport to Kichwa Tembo's private airstrip. The flights take approximately one hour. Mombasa Air operates daily flights from Mombasa. The flight takes approximately two hours. The lodge collects guests from and returns them to the airstrip, which takes 30 minutes.

## GUEST ACCOMMODATION

Two intimate camps each with just nine spacious tents with shingle roof, wooden doors and a private deck. Each tent is luxuriously furnished with gleaming wooden floors and wood-framed beds, overhead fan, twin hand basins, shower, private w.c, cupboards, leather chairs and writing table.

## GUEST AREAS

The main guest areas, shaded by a dense forest canopy, consist of a sitting area with fireplaces and verandas with views of the endless game-filled Mara plains. Beautifully hand-crafted artefacts, fine antiques, leather buttoned Chesterfield sofas, books, crystal and candlelight will transport guests back to the heyday of the romantic classic safari. A unique feature is the treeshaded lap pool with a view of the Mara. Guests are welcome to visit the Safari Shop at Kichwa Tembo Masai Mara Tented Camp.

## SAFARIS

Morning and afternoon game-drives in open game viewing vehicles. Night game drives on the camp's concession, guided nature walks with a Maasai naturalist, Maasai community visits and lectures, sundowners at a location offering spectacular views across the Mara. Hot air ballooning at an additional cost.

<b>Airstrip:</b>	Kichwa Tembo airstrip is registered and the co-ordinates are: S 01° 16' and E 35° 02'.
<b>Park Fees:</b>	US\$60 per adult per day and US\$30 for children aged 3 to 12 years (subject to change without notice).
<b>Currency:</b>	Dollar bills printed between 1996 and 1999 are NOT accepted in Kenya or Tanzania as there was a large amount of illegal processing of dollar bills in East Africa during that time. Travellers cheques are no longer accepted in Kenya due to fraud.
<b>Children:</b>	Children welcome. Regretfully, children 5 years and younger cannot participate in the regular game drives. Children aged 6 to 11 years are accommodated on game drives at the lodge manager's discretion. An extra bed can be arranged for a child 16 and younger sharing with their parents. No more than one triple per camp at any one time.
<b>Malaria:</b>	The camp is situated in a low risk malaria area

### LOCATION

&Beyond Kichwa Tembo Masai Mara Tented Camp is situated on the western border of the Masai Mara Game Reserve in southwestern Kenya. ## ACCESS

## GUEST ACCOMMODATION

40 hemingway-style safari tents (28 classic safari tents and 12 luxury tents) with ensuite bathroom. The tents are spacious and have a shower, hand basin and w.c. Each tent has two extralength three-quarter beds. Each luxury tent has a double bed that can convert to twins.

## GUEST AREAS

The guest area includes a reception, Safari Shop, bar/sitting room and indoor/outdoor dining area, all of which overlook endless, game-filled plains and are shaded by a dense forest canopy, with the Oolololo Escarpment in the background. There is a large sparkling swimming pool set among trees, surrounded by lawns and a breathtaking views.

## SAFARIS

Morning and afternoon game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles, birdwatching and daily lectures by a Maasai naturalist. Optional excursions at an additional cost include night game-drives on the lodge's private concession, guided walking trails up and along the Oolololo escarpment, a Maasai community visit, sundowners at a location with spectacular views across the Mara and hot air ballooning.

Child minders can be booked at an additional cost. Children aged 6 to 11 years are accommodated on game drives at the lodge manager's discretion. An extra bed can be arranged for a child 16 and younger sharing with their parents. No more than three triples in camp at any one time.
